Prophecy and Promise

Y3: The children will be learning about mass, with a focus on the Liturgy of the Word. They will learn how Jesus' birth was foretold by the prophets.

Y4: The children will be learning about the prophet Elijah and how he demonstrated his faith towards God. Through godly play, they will explore the story of The miracle of the flower and oil and make links to their faith.

Advent/Christmas - Loving

The children will:

- Explore the gift of love and friendship.
- Learn about the Church's season of preparing to receive God's gift of love and friendship in Jesus.

English

Wallace and Gromit

The children will be using Wallace and Gromit as a stimulus to complete various reading and writing opportunities. We will complete activities linked to action and dialogue between characters.



Biography: Nick Park

The children will be learning about the creator of Wallace and Gromit; Nick Park. They will look at lots of examples of biographical writing and create their own piece based on Nick Park.

Gymnastics

The children will:

- Demonstrate travelling with control
- Show balances on 1, 2, 3 and 4 points
- Demonstrate basic rolls with accuracy and control
- Demonstrate jumping and landing safely
- Create and demonstrate a gymnastic sequence using travelling, jumping, rolling and balancing with a change in direction and speed.



Invasion games: Rugby

The children will:

- Demonstrate passing a ball using a swing pass.
- Perform a swing pass and bounce pass in a game.
- Perform a pass in an invasion game using a swing pass.



Online Safety

The children will be learning how to stay safe online, keep their personal details safe, how to use and choose effective passwords and what to do if you don't feel safe online.

Spreadsheets

The children will be learning about collecting data and how to input this into simple spreadsheets. They will learn about columns and rows and how spreadsheets are used.

CRAFT AND DESIGN: Ancient Egyptian scrolls

- children will be learning about the way colour, scale and pattern influenced ancient Egyptian art.
- Children will explore the technique of papermaking to create a papyrus-style scroll.
- Ideas are extended to create a modern response by designing a 'zine'.

Geography

The United Kingdom (Local Study)

The children will be recapping their knowledge of where they live within the UK and also where they live on a local scale. They will be undertaking Ordnance Survey mapwork and fieldwork. Their work will culminate in planning an investigation based on the Enquiry Question: Where does our food come from?



Science

Animals Including humans (digestion, teeth)

The children will be looking at human nutrition and learning about the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system. They will also learn about different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
