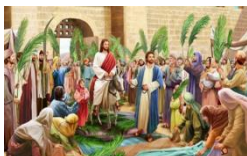

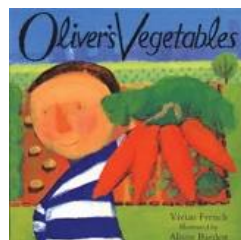
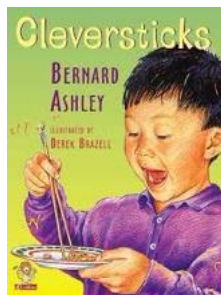

- Use the conjunction 'or' linked to a question
- Use 'if' as an opener at the start of a sentence
- Use adjectives to describe thoughts and feelings and a capital letter for the day of the week
- Use 'I' when writing a recount
- Use the conjunction 'that'
- Use an apostrophe to show contraction



Mathematics

In Year 1 we will focus on:

- Addition and subtraction (within 20)
- Place value (within 50)
- Length and height

In Year 2 we will focus on:

- Money
- Length and height
- Mass, capacity and temperature
