



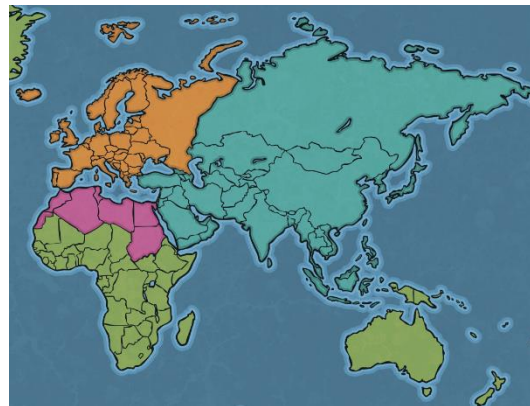
Key Vocabulary	
Remembrance	Remembering people who have died.
Evacuee	A person moved away from a place of danger.
Soldier	A person who is in an army.
Invasion	Going (invading) into a country with an army.
Citizen	someone who lives in a particular country or city.
Secondary source	an article or book that discusses information that was first presented somewhere else.
Primary source	an original object, account or document that gives information about something.
