Subject/Area of the curriculum	Key information
Communication 	Communication is vital. Please use the Seesaw app to communicate with your child's class teacher. You can message your child's class teacher anytime. Teachers will aim to reply within 24 -48hrs and ASAP if urgent. If you do not give consent to using Seesaw, please contact the class teacher via the school office email. The school office will also share information/emails via Parent Mail too.
 P.E	Our PE day will be Monday and Thursday each week. Please make sure your child wears their full outdoor kit on the specified days.
Reading at home 	The children will receive a reading book each Monday for reading at home. Please ensure that the reading books are in their bags each day as we have helpers who can listen to readers. Please question the children about the book (Who? What? Where? Why? When? questions) and ask them to prove their answers pointing to evidence from the text.
Homework 	Homework in Key Stage 1 focuses mainly on maths, English and handwriting and we encourage you to read with your child regularly. These activities will be issued either online or paper based each Friday and should remain at home. Please feel free to share via SeeSaw if you wish.
Water bottle	Please bring a clean water bottle each day – this should be filled up at home.
Snacks	Please bring a healthy snack for break time or register your child for toast.
School Uniform	Please see our school uniform policy on the website. Please note: no branded products or jewellery etc.
Please only bring a book bag into school each day with ONE small keyring!
