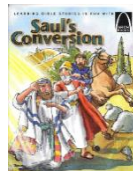

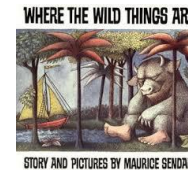
During this term we will be listening to a range of stories, riddles and non fiction text:

Y1

- Use sentence openers I have, I am, you for riddles
- Use openers His, Around, On, In
- Use a wider variety of openers e.g. Once upon a time
- Focus on using question words where and who to begin a sentence
- Add an adjective to improve a sentence

Y2

- Use conjunction openers in poetry; often, sometimes, usually
- Use an apostrophe to show singular possession
- Use a comma to separate adjectives when describing a noun
- Add the suffix -ly to change a word from an adjective to an adverb and use as a sentence opener
- Use effective word choices and create a list of adjectives to describe a noun



In Year 1 we will focus on:

- Mass and volume
- Multiplication and division

- Time
