Vocabulary	Definition
Map	A picture of a place.
Plan	A simple drawing of a place.
Aerial View	Looking at something from above (like a bird)
Route	The way we travel from one place to another.
Local Area	The place where we live and go to school.
Human geography features	Things all around us that have been built by people.
Physical geography features	Natural things we can see all around us
Direction	Which way to go – Forwards. Backwards. Left. Right.
Address	Where someone lives or a place.
Near/far	Distances between places.
Temperature	Temperature is the measure of the warmth or coldness of an object or material.
Weather	The state of the atmosphere over a particular place and time as regards heat, cloudiness, dryness, sunshine, rain etc.
