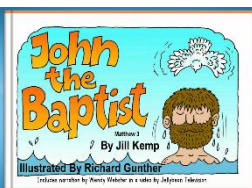

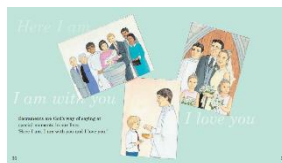
Our topic this term is Galilee to Jerusalem. We will be learning about

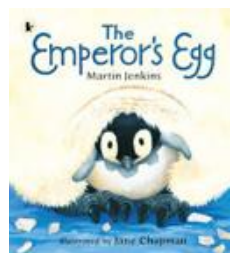

- Use commas in a list (to list adjectives in a sentence)

<p>Data explorers This unit introduces children to using software tools to group and sort recognisable objects. Children will develop their understanding of how this relates to organising and interpreting data. By the end of the unit, children have the opportunity to collect simple data and present it in a pictogram.</p> 	<p>Drawing: Understanding tone and texture Children will develop observational drawing skills when exploring mark-making. Children use a range of tools, investigating how texture can be created in drawings. They apply their skills to a collaborative piece using music as a stimulus and investigate artists Bridget Riley and Zaria Forman</p> 	<p>Health and wellbeing – safety and the changing body.</p> <p>Learning how to communicate safely with adults; learning steps to crossing the road safely; considering hazards at home; identifying which substances should or should not go in the body; learning what to do when lost; being aware of some of the risks associated with the internet; learning about appropriate and inappropriate contact</p>

<p>This half term we will be focusing on: Fundamental Movement Skills – Catching and Bouncing a ball</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To demonstrate and assess fundamental movement skills of catching and bouncing a ball with some accuracy and applying tactics in a game Gymnastic activities – jumping, travelling using hands and feet, egg, pencil and teddy bear rolls. Use these skills to create a sequence of travelling, balancing, rolling and jumping. 	<p>I Wanna Play In A Band is a Rock song written especially for children. In this song the children will learn about singing and playing together in an ensemble.</p> <p>As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs.</p>
