Bakery	A shop where bread is made and sold.
Diary	A book that people write about their lives in.
Firefighter	People who put out fires as their jobs.
St. Paul's Cathedral	A very large church in London. St. Paul's Cathedral was rebuilt by Sir Christopher Wren after the fire.
Rebuilt	Building something again after it has been broken or destroyed.
River Thames	The river that runs through the middle of London.
17 <sup>th</sup> Century	From the year 1601 - 1700. The Great Fire of London happened in the 17 <sup>th</sup> Century, in 1666.
Pudding Lane	Where the fire started.

Year 1: Children have talked about events in the past such as birthdays and Christmas and developed their understanding of growth and changes over time.

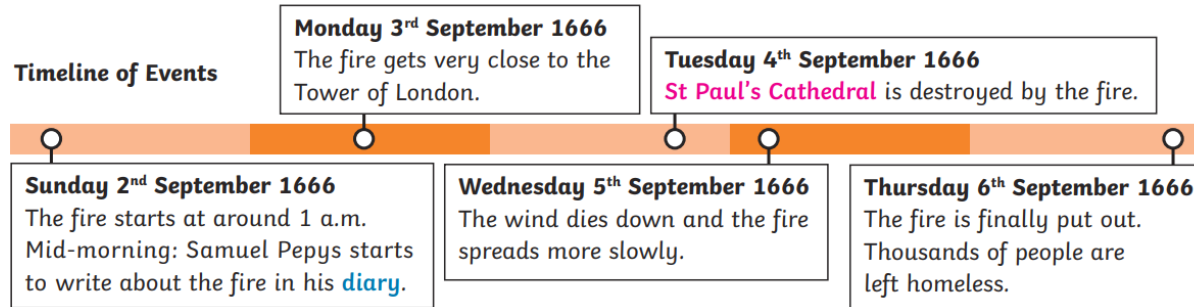
Year 2: Children explored significant people and events from the past. They've looked at how life has changed since a significant event and how we know about significant events.



### Samuel Pepys

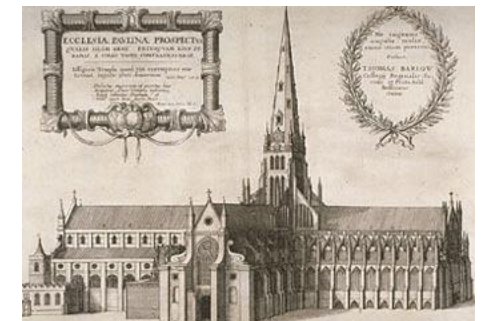
He wrote a diary recording the events during the fire.
